# FIRST CIRCULAR 27<sup>th</sup> January 2018

Conference dates: 21 – 25 January 2019

Dear Colleagues,

The Department of Antiquities of Jordan and the University of Florence are pleased to announce the *14th International Conference on the History and Archaeology of Jordan*, which will be held in Florence, Italy, from the 21<sup>st</sup> to the 25<sup>th</sup> of January 2019.

The ICHAJ conference, organized every three years, is an event of primary importance for the scientific community of archaeologists and historians who, at an international level, are interested in Jordan, the Middle East, the Mediterranean and the long-term Euro-Mediterranean cultural relations. The first ICHAJ conference was held in Oxford in 1980, as an initiative of HRH Prince Hassan bin Talal, one of the world's leading intellectuals of the Arab world, under whose patronage the conference continues to be organized.

Since 1980, the ICHAJ conference has been hosted in the major cultural capitals and in the most important research institutes of the world. The Florence edition in January 2019 is preceded by the editions in Amman (2016 - Princess Sumaya University), Berlin (2013 - Humboldt Universitat), Paris (2010 - University Paris- 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne) and Washington (2007 - George Washington University).

The ICHAJ conference aims at highlighting the role played by the historical communities attested in Jordan in the development of the Euro-Mediterranean and Near Eastern Civilizations. The theme chosen for the 2019 edition, "Culture in Crisis: flows of People, Artifacts and Ideas", adds

value to the scientific commitment to interpret 'crisis' as an accelerator of historical processes and as a release and spread of creative energy among social/cultural groups. In this framework, the ICHAJ aspires to integrate scientific knowledge and the civilizing mission of science as a tool for regional and global participation, and to contrast all instrumental and propaganda uses of history.

#### CONFERENCE VENUE

The plenary opening session will take place in the "Salone dei Cinquecento" in Palazzo Vecchio on the 21<sup>st</sup> of January 2019. Working sessions will be held in the lecture rooms of the University of Florence.

ICHAJ related academic and social events will be located in the historical city center of Florence.

## **HOW TO PARTICIPATE**

In order to present a paper or a poster at the ICHAJ 14, candidate participants are required to send an Abstract via email to: **scicom@ichaj.org** before the 20<sup>th</sup> of April 2018 according to the following specifications:

# 20th April 2018: Deadline for candidate participants for presenting Abstracts

Abstract specifications: Maximum 250 words; Clear title; Name, affiliation/s and contacts of the author/s; When proposals concern multiple Authors, list the person who will read the paper (Speaker); Each candidate may submit only one paper as a Speaker.

Specify if the Abstract is intended for a Paper, indicating the related section (I-IV) and sub-section (if applicable), or for a Poster presentation (section V).

The attached <u>abstract template</u> can be downloaded directly also from the ICHAJ official website <u>www.ichaj.org</u>

Requirements for presenting a proposal for a PAPER: first author MUST hold a PhD or be a PhD candidate. Papers can also be presented by members of the DoA and by members of academic and research institutions.

Required title for presenting a proposal for a POSTER (section V): participants MUST hold a Master Degree (MA) or equivalent.

After the evaluation of abstracts the Scientific Committee can propose to the candidate participant/s to present a poster instead of a paper and *vice-versa*.

Posters are in digital format and will be displayed only on video in a dedicated room, where a special poster session will take place.

IMPORTANT: No papers or posters dealing with unprovenanced artefacts will be accepted.

# 20th June 2018: Abstracts Evaluated

Information on accepted proposals will be sent to the authors via e-mail. Accepted abstracts will be published on the official website by the 30<sup>th</sup> of June 2018 and will be printed in the ICHAJ 14 Program/Abstracts Book.

#### **REGISTRATION & FEES**

All Authors of approved Abstracts must complete REGISTRATION for the ICHAJ 14

In case of a paper or poster with more than one Author, at least one must register as a Speaker.

Registration will take place directly on the ICHAJ official website.
